

First Rally Fee of a Dog (each Trial)..... \$35.00
Each Additional Rally Entry for same Dog, same Trial \$30.00
Each first Rally entry fee of a dog includes an AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50. Each additional Rally entry fee for same dog includes \$3.00 Recording Fee.

Obedience & Rally Information

Obedience Trial Information:

- Exhibitors should specify their dog's jump height for classes with jumps.
- Dogs will be sorted by jump height. ENTRIES LIMIT IS 60.

Rally Trial Information:

- The Rally trials are limited to 60 entries each.
- RAE and RACH classes offered.
- Rally classes will be judged in Ascending order in Advanced, Excellent and Master classes. Exhibitors MUST specify their dog's jump height in these classes as follows:
 4" for dogs under 10" at withers 12" for dogs 15" and under 20" at withers
 8" for dogs 10" and under 15" at withers 16" for dogs 20" and over
- Rally Ring size will be 40 x 60.
- Wait List: The Club will establish a wait list to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to close of entries. The full entry fee shall be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry.

2. The Ch. O'Linda of Georjune UD Memorial Award: Silverplated Wine Cooler is offered by MBDT to the Highest Scoring Dog, Combined Score, Open B and Utility.
3. The Mischievous Imp CD Memorial Award: Silverplated Water Pitcher is offered by Denise and Tom Panzich to the Highest Scoring Dog from the Toy Group in the Regular Classes.
4. The Dorothy Donoghue Memorial Award: Silverplated Candlesticks is offered by the Friends of Dorothy Donoghue to the Highest Scoring Dog in Herding Group in the Regular Classes.
5. The Tish Memorial Award: Pewter-finished 8 inch Pocketwatch Alarm Clock is offered by MBDT to the highest scoring All American (Mixed Breed) in the Regular Classes.

Obedience Special Awards

The following Special Award prizes are dog items donated by a club member. All awards apply to qualifying scores earned in the Regular Obedience Trial classes unless otherwise specified. You must register at the check-in desk to be eligible. Donors will be acknowledged.

GROUP PRIZES: A Dog Item will be offered for Highest Scoring Dog in the Hound Group and the Terrier Group.

BREED PRIZES: A Dog Item will be offered for Highest Scoring Dog in the following breeds: Golden Retriever, Labrador Retriever, Poodle, Miniature Schnauzer, and Sheltand Sheepdog.

OTHER PRIZES: None at this trial.

Please be sure to include your dog's titles for eligibility for the above award.

Notice to Exhibitors

UNSIGNED OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 per first entry and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including, but not limited to, extreme heat, snow-storms or hurricanes) or any other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Refunds for bitches in season will be given less \$10.00 for administrative fees. Written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before judging starts.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of entries will be made as soon as possible after the closing date. Should such acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor within 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.

CLASS TRANSFERS (Move-Ups) to the next level class are permitted in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a Move-up must be made in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-up forms for Obedience and Rally will be available at the Secretary's table. The Trial Secretary will also accept move-ups prior to the event.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season may be requested as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.

Additional Trial Rules

1. The Club and Management will attempt to exercise every precaution for the safety of all dogs and people. However, neither the Club nor the Management will be responsible for injury or loss.
2. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry. Please PRINT or TYPE all information on entry form.
3. In case of a tie for any prize, any dog not present for a runoff forfeits the right to the prize.
4. No awards will be mailed or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award for him/her on the day the award is earned.
5. There is no admission charge to spectators.
6. This is a SELF CLEANING SHOW. Please clean up after your dogs.
7. Early arrivals should respect sleeping residents by monitoring noise levels, keeping dogs under control, and quieting excessive barking.
8. No alcoholic beverages or smoking of any kind are permitted on the grounds.

Emailed Entries - Pay Entry Fees with PayPal

Entries may be emailed to the Trial Secretary at kek@bumpsays.com. Emailed entries MUST INCLUDE THE AGREEMENT printed alongside the Official AKC Entry Form. Print out the entry form (both sides together), fill it out and sign it. Entries are not valid without your signature. Then either scan the entry to a PDF file, or take a picture with your smart phone.

PAY ENTRY FEES WITH PAYPAL: To make your payment for emailed entries, go to www.bumpsays.com to pay by paypal or credit card. There is a \$2.00 fee for each dog entered for using PayPal to cover service fees. Entries are not valid until fees are paid, which must be on or before the closing date.

INFODOG – If you use online entry via Infodog (MBF), be aware that you must submit your entry several days early. Infodog will charge you as much as \$15.00 additional per entry.

Trial Site

These trials will be held at Manzanita Park in Prunedale. Please follow all parking instructions and regulations. No overnight RV or tent camping is offered at the show site.

Lunch will NOT be provided. Please bring your own lunch, beverages and snacks.

Directions to Show Site - Manzanita Park

From Highway 1 North or South. Head East on Dolan Rd. At 3.4 miles the road becomes Castroville Blvd. After 2.5 miles look for the sign on your right for Manzanita Park.

From Highway 101 Heading East. The site is about 50 minutes south of San Jose. Take the San Miguel Canyon Rd exit off 101 in Prunedale. Proceed about one mile west on San Miguel. Turn left onto Castroville Blvd. Proceed .8 miles to the sign for Manzanita Park on your left.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed". Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information should remain blank for mixed breed entrants

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

(Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
