Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special Rosette and pole. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin.

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Regular and Preferred Premier Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm up jump will be provided.

COVID Disclaimer

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID exists in any public place where people are present. COVID is extremely contagious and can lead to severe illness. By entering and attending this trial, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID. All CDC, State and County guidelines related to COVID will be closely followed. Our health and safety is of utmost importance.

Guidelines will be included in the Schedule letter which will be available five days before the event.

Those who have been fully vaccinated against COVID are not required to wear a face mask. All others are required to wear a face mask unless they are in their personal vehicle or in their personal crating area.

By signing entry form for this event exhibitor agrees to the following: I attest to the best of my knowledge that I do not have COVID at the time of attending this event. I also attest that I have not knowingly been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID within the past 14 days. I will follow all AKC, Hosting Club, City, County and State rules and requirements to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus during the event.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing /Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee
- After closing bitches in season will receive refund of amount paid less \$10 per day processing fee
- Refunds for withdraw before closing date will be sent 7 days after the event. \$7 processing fee on all refunds.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, an act of God, and act of Mother Nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee
- Refunds are sent 7 days after the event
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
