Reznor is 13 years 10 months and loving life especially when he can walk or swim. (Garth & Terri Gregson)




so we can all get together and play with our dogs. My dogs made me proud and knocked it out of the park.

Soleil found all the hides in the 4 Masters classes but unfortunately for her, I made a bad assumption so she only earned 3 Qs, but all with


placements. And as we all know, she doesn't care and she still loves me.
