## The BRAGS Continue!

**Holly** had a successful 3-day Scent Work Trial at Lost Coast Kennel Club in Eureka on Labor Day weekend.

We competed in both Advanced and Excellent (which was a lot of sniffing over three days). Overall, in Advanced we had 13 Qs out of 15 searches; in Excellent we had 6 Qs out of 12 searches.

She completed her Advanced Handler Discrimination title with two 1st places and a 3rd, finished the Excellent Buried and Container element titles with two 4th place ribbons in Excellent Container. We picked up one leg each in Excellent Interior and Exterior. The NQs were due, as always, to handler error (except being excused for having an "accident" on the field ( ).

As always, I learned the most from the NQs, namely (1) remember how many hides there are and (2) don't call Finish too soon. I won't try that many searches again -- after 27 searches in 3 days, I got confused jumping between 2 and 3 hides, and Holly was a tired Sheltie at the end of the weekend. She is only 3 legs short of the SWE title, and we are planning on staying at Excellent level until we get more consistent in Interior. I'm very proud of Holly -- she has come a long way from her crazy puppy days, and she really seems to enjoy doing scent work............ (Denise Weatherwax)
